1 The Parties' Joint Motion to Approve Second Prophylaxis Class Notice is GRANTED, and  
2 Plaintiffs' Motion to Approve Second Prophylaxis Class Notice is STRICKEN as moot. It is  
3 further ORDERED:

4 1. Defendant volunteered and will pay the costs of mailing the Class Notice and

7 Administrator. JND shall use a list of Class Members and their last known addresses on a

10 as a Class Member consents to its disclosure.

11 3. A 60-day period will be used for the requested return date of the **Statement of**  
12 **Intent to Pursue Damages Claim for Parents and Children** form.
